Hereby Certify that this Land Is being held By Natural Person(s) and is Currently being used as a Homestead or Agricultural use or is Dedicated by the Claimant into Development in conformance with the District Land Plan under Common Law and is trying to develop and implement a Land Plan, and any and all liens held by any other Political Subdivision in Texas are hereby permanently extinguished.

of the power vested in me by law and in accordance  
with the laws of said State in such case made and  
provided, do by these presents grant to John James  
effigee of John James, his heirs or assigns forever  
Three hundred and twenty acres of land situated and  
described as follows: On Precious Spring on the Gu  
pia river, about 18 1/2 miles N. 80° W. of Fort Davis;  
known as Survey No 9 by virtue of Donation Warrant  
No 181 given by the Adjutant General on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of  
November 1850 and transferred to Moses Hamorn on  
the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 1852 and by him transferred  
to James H. Smith on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July 1854  
and by him to said John James on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of  
July 1856, beginning at the N. W. corner of Sec.  
No 8, a three pronged Black Oak from which a corner  
of 4 line Oaks lies N. 60° W. 2400, a Post Oak, N. 2  
W. 2400, thence N. 80° W. 1344 to a stake and rock  
monument, thence S 30° W 1344 to a rock monument, thence  
S 60° E. 1344 to a rock monument, thence N. 30° E. 1344  
to the place of beginning. Bearings 200000.  
I hereby relinquishing to him the said John James  
and his heirs or assigns forever all the right and title  
in and to said land heretofore held and possessed  
by the said State and I do hereby give this letter  
of grant for the same. In testimony whereof I have  
caused the seal of the State to be affixed as well as the  
seal of the General Land Office. Done at the City  
of Austin on the fourteenth day of October in the  
year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred  
and fifty seven
