THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS dismissed case number 95-1002 for want of jurisdiction.

In the letter dated November 16, 1995 regarding case number 95-1002 and styled "IN RE: THE PEOPLE OF THE REPUBLIC OF TEXAS by and through RICHARD L.
